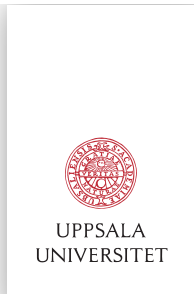

Need medical help?

- **Make an appointment at your local healthcare centre.**
- Use www.1177.se or call 1177 to find out where to go
- In case of Emergency call 112
- **You'll need to pay for your visit.**
- Some health care providers may issue an invoice, late payment of invoices comes with an additional fee. Make sure to pay in time.
- Missed appointments might mean that you still will get charged, be in time for your appointment
- It is not always you get to see a doctor, sometimes you get to meet a qualified nurse who make the first exam and in case needed referes you to a doctor



Having Dental issues?

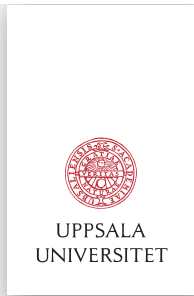
- Make an appointment

- Dental care is expensive – even for Swedes and those holding a personal number
- It is important to note that dental care is treated differently from other medical services. While standard healthcare may include government subsidies, dental care has fewer of these

In need of glasses?

- Eyes are checked by an optician. Synsam, Specsavers, Smarteyes, Synoptik are some of the chains in Sweden.
- In case of problems you are being referred to an Optometrist
- Basic need of eye wear is not considered medical in Sweden and there are no governmental subsidies for adults. You pay for the glasses.
- Some employers offers terminal glasses for screenwork, often very basic glasses with few frames to choose from and nothing "extra". Procured processes always applies.
